

Bunny Treasure Pouch

Materials list

1. Wool felt - in your choice of colour - you will need a square about 19cm x 17cm per pouch (see the pattern sheet for exact details). I used some beautiful hand dyed felt in lilac and lemon & some beautiful eco felt (in a natural shade).

2. Perle cotton - to gather and form the drawstring on your treasure pouch. You could also use embroidery thread (the full 6 strands) however I do find the perle cotton is easier to work with and makes it easy for the little pouch to be opened and closed. You will need two pieces approx. 60cm each.

3. Fabric scraps to make your inner ears .

4. Embroidery cotton/floss - in a colour to complement the fabric for the inner ears.

5. Sewing needles - I used an embroidery needle for attaching the fabric onto the ears and chenille needle for creating the gathering stitch with my perle cotton.

6. Scissors & pins

7. Beads to embellish the ends of your drawstring ties.



project notes...

This project works well with both commercially dyed felt or hand dyed felt. Make sure the felt you use is 100% wool felt, as it really makes such a difference in the quality of what you create.

Remember to use the Magical Wool Felt if you'd like to create your own beautiful colours. You could use some turmeric to achieve something similar to the yellow I use in the video.

Consider upcycling fabrics for the inner ear of your bunny pouches - for example I love using the fabric from the girls' old dresses & tops.
